My works are infused with 18 carat gold, a transitional mineral that reflects in the light, which I in turn manipulate and layer to change texture, giving each of my pieces increased movement and energy, thus affording each creation velocity. Gold is internationally appealing, and evokes integrity, sophistication, and elegance, providing an alluring value to my work. My Acrylic Series is a painting in reverse. The translucent works are completed in a series of sittings, and multi-layered from behind over time, rendering an uncontrolled, unpredictable, primal result.


